

WJFK-FM HOME RUN CONTEST Official Contest Rules

These contest rules are specific to the WJFK-FM Home Run Contest (the “**Contest**”) conducted by Audacy Washington DC, LLC d/b/a WJFK-FM-FM (the “**Station**”). Except to the extent specifically set forth below with respect to this specific Contest, the Station’s general contest rules apply to this Contest as well. A copy of these specific Contest rules and the Station’s general contest rules are available on the Station’s website at www.thefandc.com/rules. **To the extent the general contest rules differ from these rules, these rules will govern and control with respect to this Contest.**

Who Can Enter

1. **NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR TO WIN THE CONTEST. A PURCHASE OR PAYMENT WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING.**
2. To be eligible to participate in this Contest, entrants must be legal U.S. residents of Washington, DC, Maryland, Virginia, or West Virginia, and must be 18 years of age or older as of date of entry in this Contest.
3. Employees of Station, Safeway, or any other sponsors participating in this Contest and their respective affiliated companies, advertising or promotional agencies and the immediate family and household members (*as defined in the Station’s general contest rules*) of each are ineligible to participate in this Contest.
4. Maximum of one (1) entry per email address during the entire Registration Period (*as defined in Section 7 below*).
5. Any one (1) individual may only be a verified Winner and receive a prize one (1) time in this Contest, if at all.
6. All entries not already selected as a Winner will rollover to subsequent Winner selections, if any.

How to Enter

7. To enter beginning at 12:00am (ET) on Thursday, March 26th, 2026 and ending at 12:00pm (ET) on Sunday, September 27, 2026 (the “**Registration Period**”), visit www.thefandc.com/contests and follow the links to the entry form. Follow the online instructions provided to complete and submit the online entry form with all of the required information including name, complete address (*including City, State, Zip*), valid email address, age, and phone number(s) (*including area code(s)*). All online entries must be received by **12:00pm (ET) on Sunday, September 27, 2026** to be eligible.
8. Qualifying games and game dates for this Contest shall be the one-hundred and sixty-two (162) designated regular season Washington DC professional baseball team (the “**Team**”) baseball games scheduled to be played between Thursday, March 25th, 2026, and Sunday, September 27, 2026 (“**Qualifying Game(s)**”).

How to Win

9. Subject to the conditions set forth below in these Contest rules, if a player on the Washington D.C. professional baseball team (“**Team**”) scores a Home Run(s) (*as defined in Section 10 below*) in the second (2nd) inning during any regular season Qualifying Game then at approximately 1:00pm (ET) on the business day immediately following the day of that Qualifying Game, one (1) Winner shall be randomly selected from among all entries

received by 11:59pm (ET) on the day before that Qualifying Game (“**Winner**”) and will, upon verification of eligibility and compliance with these rules, receive a Prize (*as defined in Section 12*). If the Team does not score a Home Run in the second (2nd) inning of a Qualifying Game, then no winner will be selected and no Prize awarded for that Qualifying Game.

10. For the purposes of this Contest, in order for a score to be considered a valid Home Run it must meet the conditions as set forth below (“**Home Run**”).
 - a. The ball must clear the outfield fence on the fly, without the aid of an opposing player or any other person, surface or object. A ball that touches a fielder prior to crossing the plane of the outfield fence will not constitute a winning Home Run for this Contest, irrespective of the official scoring of the play.
 - b. Any Home Run, which occurs as the result of a spectator who in any way interferes with an opposing player who is attempting to catch the ball (i.e. grabbing a player’s arm, removing ball from a player’s glove, etc.), will not constitute a winning Home Run for this Contest, irrespective of the official scoring of the play.
 - c. An inside-the-park Home Run may constitute as a winning Home Run for this Contest as long as it is officially scored as an inside the park Home Run.
 - d. Each designated Qualifying Game must be recorded as an official game.
 - e. No winner shall be selected and no prize awarded based on the outcome of any Home Run(s) made outside of the second (2nd) inning of any Qualifying Game.
 - f. If the Qualifying Game in which a batter has hit a Home Run in the second (2nd) inning is canceled for any reason prior to becoming an official game, all hits are removed from the official score book and there will be no Winner selected for that Qualifying Game.
 - g. No changes by the official scorer on any ruling (*i.e. changing an error or a fielder’s choice to a Home Run*) will be acknowledged after the completion of the Qualifying Game.
 - h. If a Qualifying Game is rescheduled or postponed for any reason, before or after the completion of the second (2nd) inning, there will be no selection of a Winner and no until the day after the official completion of the game.
 - i. If a Qualifying Game is cancelled and no make-up game is schedule, even if the cancellation happens after the completion of the second (2nd) inning, then no winner will be selected for that Qualifying Game.
 - j. No changes by the official scorer on any ruling (i.e. changing an error or a fielder’s choice to a home run) will be acknowledged after the official completion of any Qualifying Game.
11. Should there be more than one (1) official Home Run scored within the second (2nd) inning of a Qualifying Game, there will still only be one (1) Winner selected for that Qualifying Game.

Prize(s)

12. There will be up to one hundred sixty-two (162) Winners in this Contest, if any. Upon verification of eligibility, each Winner will receive one (1) \$100 Safeway gift card (“**Prize**”), courtesy of Safeway.

Odds of Winning

13. The odds of becoming a Winner in the Contest depends on the number of eligible entrants received, the number of drawings each entrant is included in, and the play of the Team for each Qualifying Game.

Sponsors

14. The Sponsors of this Contest are Audacy Washington D.C., LLC and Safeway.

Other Rules Specific to This Contest

15. The entry process may require Entrants to login to, or to create, a free account with the third party provider of a software platform used by the Station for such Contest(s) ("**Software Provider**"), by going to the Website, clicking on the Contest entry link, and completing and submitting the online registration form with all required information.
- a. Limit one (1) account with the Software Provider per email address.
 - b. Software Provider is not a sponsor of this Contest, but Entrants may be required, as part of the entry process, to agree and consent to the Software Provider's terms of service and/or privacy policy, both of which will be available via a link during the entry or account registration process (collectively, the "**Software Provider Policies**").
 - c. If the Entrant elects to have their entry form pre-loaded or pre-populated with information from the Entrant's Facebook, Twitter, Google, or LinkedIn profiles, such Entrant authorizes the Software Provider and the Station to access, utilize and/or pre-load to such entry form, applicable portions of Entrant's profile information from such account.
 - d. While agreement to the Software Provider Policies may be required in order to enter the Contest, the Software Provider Policies are not a part of these Contest Rules but are a separate agreement between the Entrant and Software Provider. In the event of any conflict between the Software Provider Policies and the Rules, the Rules will govern.
 - e. Station is not responsible for any error or technical malfunctions associated with the Software Provider site that may affect any Entrant's ability to enter, to win, or to be properly considered in the Contest, regardless of the cause. In the event of a malfunction associated with the Software Provider site that the Station in its sole and absolute discretion deems to materially and adversely affect the Contest, the Station reserves the right to (1) suspend the Contest; (2) terminate the Contest without a Winner; (3) terminate the Contest and select a Winner early; (4) provide alternative means of entry; and/or make any other changes to the Contest that the Station deems appropriate under the circumstances. Any such changes, terminations or suspensions will be published on the Contest Rules Page, and in the Station's sole and absolute discretion, may also be announced on-air, published elsewhere on the Website, and/or published on social media.
 - f. Employees of Software Provider and its affiliates, their respective parents, affiliates, subsidiaries, advertising sponsors and promotional agencies, and the immediate family members of each are not eligible to win in this Contest.
